Theatre Assistant:

Most theatre companies are fully prepared to execute every aspect of their productions, but there are occasional opportunities for our volunteers to assist with:

- Loading in set pieces, props and other items.
- Hanging, positioning and removing lights from the ceiling.
- Positioning microphones, cabling and other audio needs.
- Setting up the projector and other video equipment.
- Reconfiguring seating and risers.
- Sweeping/mopping theatre floors and reorganizing equipment during load-out.
